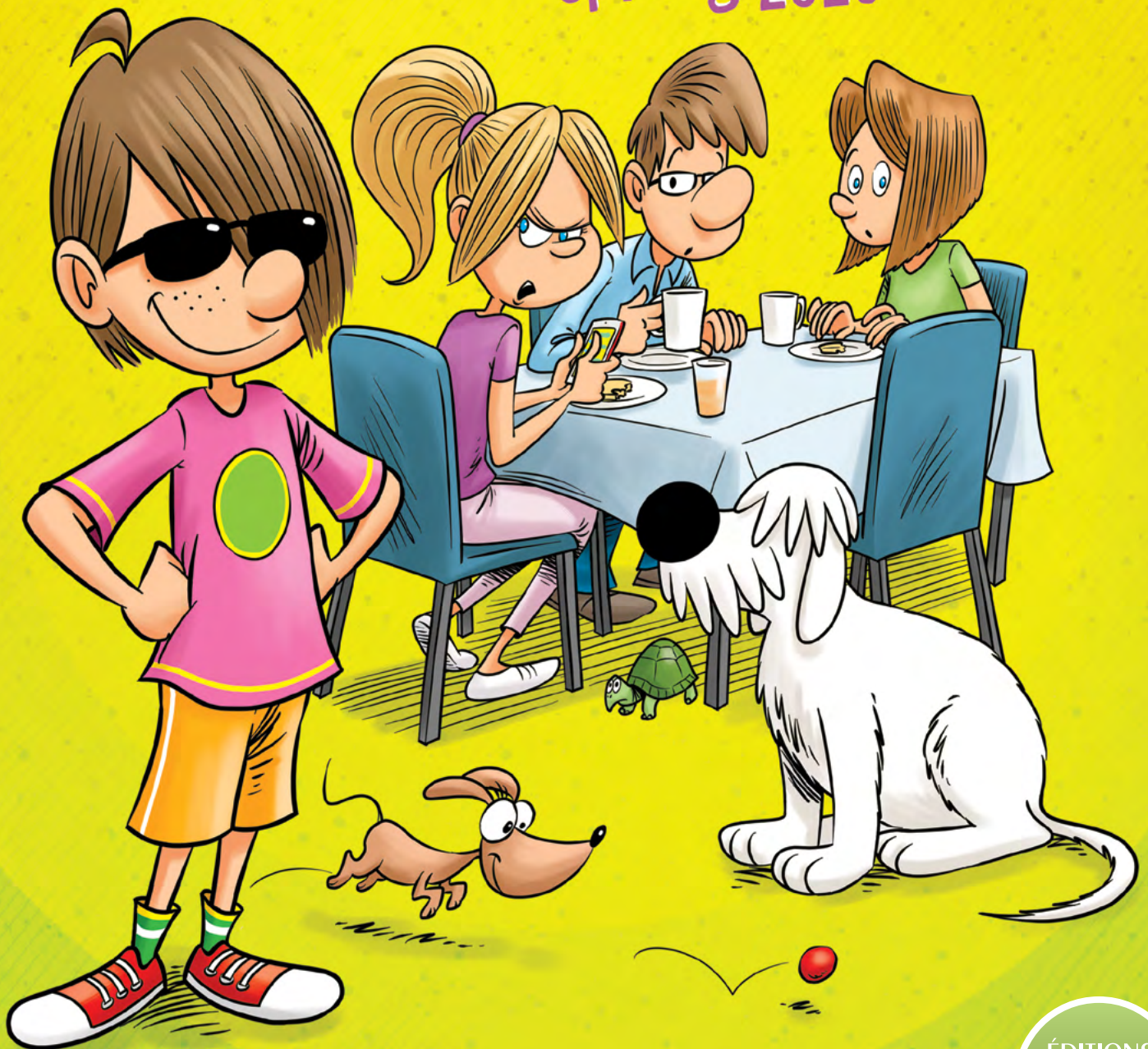

Established in 1982 by a veterinarian, **Éditions Michel Quintin** initially focused on publishing popular science books about animals, nature, and the environment.

Thanks to the dedication of a savvy, dynamic team with an eye for daring, original ideas, the publishing house list later grew to include all genres of novels, picture books and comic books in addition to educational and reference guides.

Today, it's one of the leading contributors to young adult literature and ranks as the 4th largest publisher of franco-phone comic books and graphic novels in Canada.

These efforts to publish an increasing variety of quality books have resulted in prestigious awards and a loyal following of young and adult readers. Around fifty new titles are added to the in-house catalogue every year, which now consists of **1,000 publications**, including 300 digital books, several bestsellers and international editions.

An animation college graduate, Richard Vallerand has been active in 2D and short film animation for the past twenty years. Before devoting himself to his art full time, he also worked in graphic design and development for entertainment giants, like Warner Brothers and Disney for many years. When the opportunity to start his own practice came along thanks in part to Dijef, he leapt and cofounded *La shop à bulle* workshop, a creative space dedicated to comic strips. **The LabRats** (*Les Laborats*) combines comic strips published in the popular science magazine for teens, *Curium*.

Patrick Bizier AUTHOR, ILLUSTRATOR

I don't like straight lines. I prefer when they break. I like them organic and lively. I want to see them curve and mesh together, creating something altogether new. I want them to transport me somewhere else. I love the accidents that happen along the way.

After earning a BFA from the Université du Québec à Montréal, Patrick Bizier moved to Grenoble in 1985 to specialize in etching. He then turned his attention to graphic design and illustration.

Alongside his commercial work, he has also had his work featured in exhibitions, books, and magazines. A comic book lover since forever, he published his first comic book **The Admiral and the Fool** (*L'Amiral et l'Andouille*) through Éditions Michel Quintin.



Richard Goyette

Freg AUTHOR, ILLUSTRATOR

A native of Quebec City, Freg majored in graphic design before becoming a full-time author and illustrator. Drawn to several art disciplines at once - including improvisation, photography, drawing, and humour - he combined his many interests in his first comic book, published by Éditions Petit Homme in 2013. Since then, he has travelled across Quebec leading activities and educational workshops in schools. Today, his portfolio includes several series: *The Smikee Gang* (*La Bande à Smikee*), *Leo P., Private Detective* (*Léo P., détective privé*), **Doctor Rip** (*Docteur RIP*), and **MultiMax**.

Velm AUTHOR, ILLUSTRATOR

Valerie is my name. I like comics (creating and reading them), drawing, drinking (sometimes coffee, sometimes beer), movies, and animals. That's about it!

A native of Laval, Velm joined the Old Montreal comic arts program in 2012. In 2014, she started working on comic strips and in 2015, her webcomic *La première* was a finalist in the renowned Angouleme Festival's *Révélation Blog* competition. Today, she continues to make her way in the Quebec comic art scene. After the publication of the trilogy **The First** (*La première*), a graphic novel for young adults, she started to work on the new series for children's, **The Agraoba** (*L'Agraoba*).





Tristan Demers AUTHOR, ILLUSTRATOR

Tristan Demers has been a part of Quebec's cultural scene for over 35 years. He created his iconic character **Gargoyle** (*Gargouille*) when he was just 10 years old and has since won many awards.

His studio has produced several French comic books featuring popular toys, such as the *Trash Packs* and the *Shopkins*. Over the years, Tristan Demers has attended 300 book fairs around the world and hosted kids' TV shows (*Dessinatruc*, *Transformatruc*, *BAM*) for major networks, including Canadian public television and Yoopa.

Sacha Lefebvre, ILLUSTRATOR

A full-time illustrator since 2010, Sacha Lefebvre majored in design and illustration at Dawson College. Greatly inspired by American comic books, his love for superheroes and action fill the pages of his work. Illustrator of the series **U-MERLIN**.

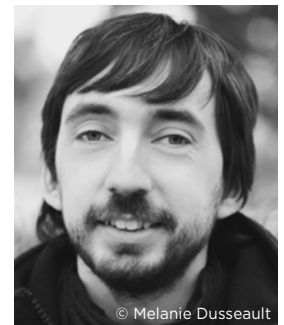


Jean-François Laliberté, AUTHOR

Novelist, screenplay writer, engineer, and father of two, Jean-François Laliberté juggles his multiple roles with aplomb. He studied literature at the Université du Québec à Montréal and operations and logistics at the *École de Technologie Supérieure*. His diverse background and varied interests now serve as inspiration for his work. In 2012, one of his short stories won a major Quebec award for thrillers. Author of the series **U-MERLIN**.

Jipi Perreault AUTHOR, ILLUSTRATOR

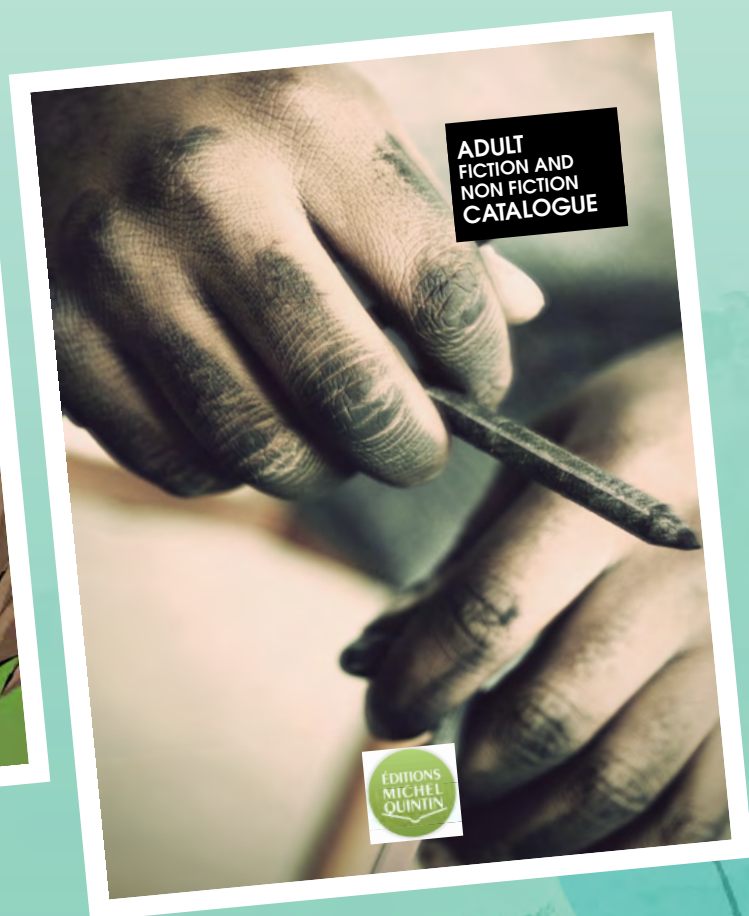
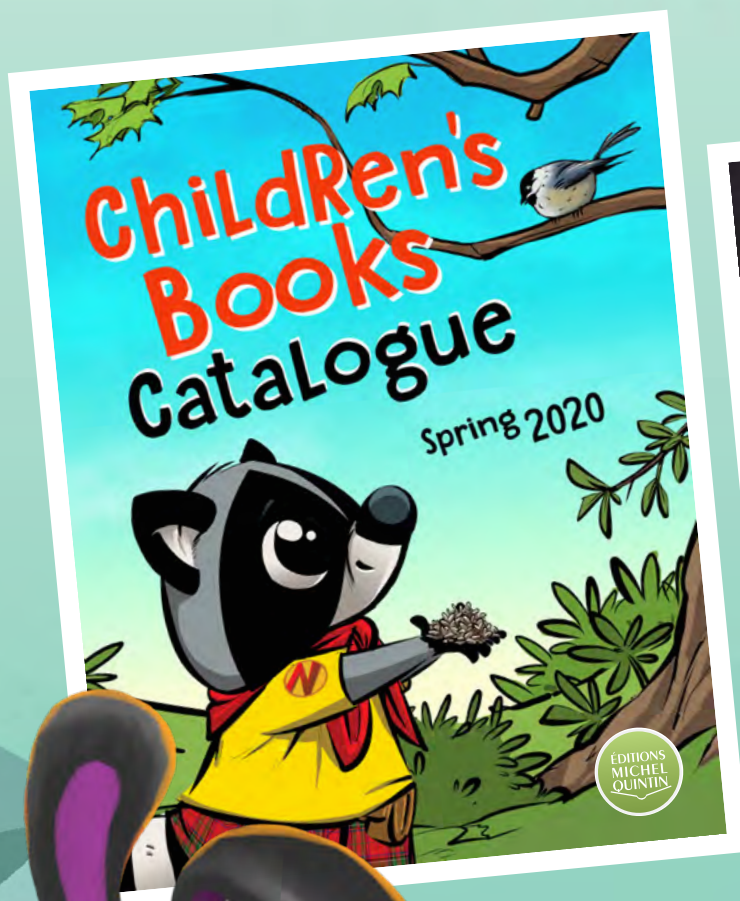
Born in Abitibi, Jipi Perreault studied the art of comic books at the Université du Québec en Outaouais. Due to a visual handicap, he had to develop a special technique that has become his signature style. Since 2012, when he self-published his first series *Fearless Man*, his work has mainly focused on superhero universes. In 2014, his character *Rose du ciel* (*Sky's Rose*) was introduced in *Le Front #7*, a collective published by *Front Froid Publishing*. He has since collaborated on multiple occasions with the comic book magazine *Planches*. Author and illustrator of **Sky's Rose** (*La Rose du ciel*).



Madaule AUTHOR, ILLUSTRATOR

Born in Castres, France, Bruno Madaule studied at the Architecture's School in Toulouse. In 2000, he collaborated on the album *Mini guide du Foot* (*Mini Guide to Soccer*) published by Editions Vents d'Ouest. He then won the BEDEBU contest in Belgium and was nominated for the "Young talent" exhibition in Angoulême in 2001. He began his career that same year when he, Jacky Goupil and Sylvia Douyé, created the series *Les Zinzinventeurs*, published by Editions Casterman. In 2002, the first volume of this series won the *Alph'Art* award for Best Youth Comic (7/8 years) in Angoulême. Today, Madaule draws for several comic magazines published around the world: *Wapiti*, *Spirou*, *Psikopat*, *Lanfeust Mag* and *L'Echo des Savanes*. Author and illustrator of the series **Brain Freeze** (*Givrés!*).
