Established in 1982 by a veterinarian, **Éditions Michel Quintin** initially focused on publishing popular science books about animals, nature, and the environment.

Thanks to the dedication of a savvy, dynamic team with an eye for daring, original ideas, the publishing house list later grew to include all genres of novels, picture books and comic books in addition to educational and reference guides.

Today, it's one of the leading contributors to young adult literature and ranks as the 4th largest publisher of franco-phone comic books and graphic novels in Canada.

These efforts to publish an increasing variety of quality books have resulted in prestigious awards and a loyal following of young and adult readers. Around fifty new titles are added to the in-house catalogue every year, which now consists of **1,000 publications**, with an additional 300 digital books, several bestsellers and international editions.

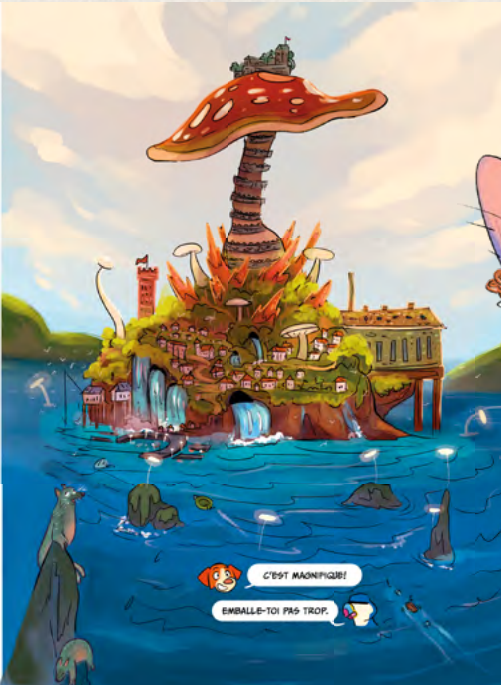
Maple is a curious, creative, clumsy, scattered 13-year-old girl who is passionate about animals. So far, everything seems normal.

THE THREE HUNDRED AND SIXTY DEGREES OF THE SUN

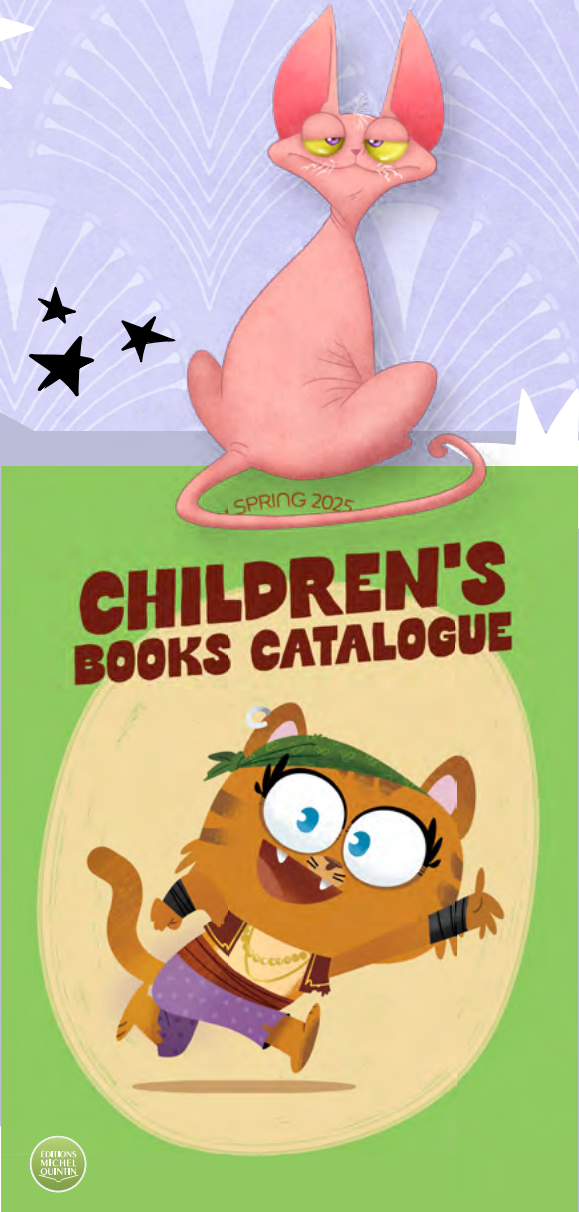
